Doctoral dissertation

- (1) Regarding the method of applying for a degree and the format of the dissertation, refer to the "Doctoral Dissertation Application Guidelines" distributed by the Educational Affairs Section.
- (2) The structure of a doctoral dissertation differs depending on the field of study, but basically the structure follows the composition shown in the next section. For details on how to write citations, follows the standard form of the relevant research field.
- (3) In principle, the doctoral dissertation should be in English. When written in English, students must undergo English proofreading by a professional.
